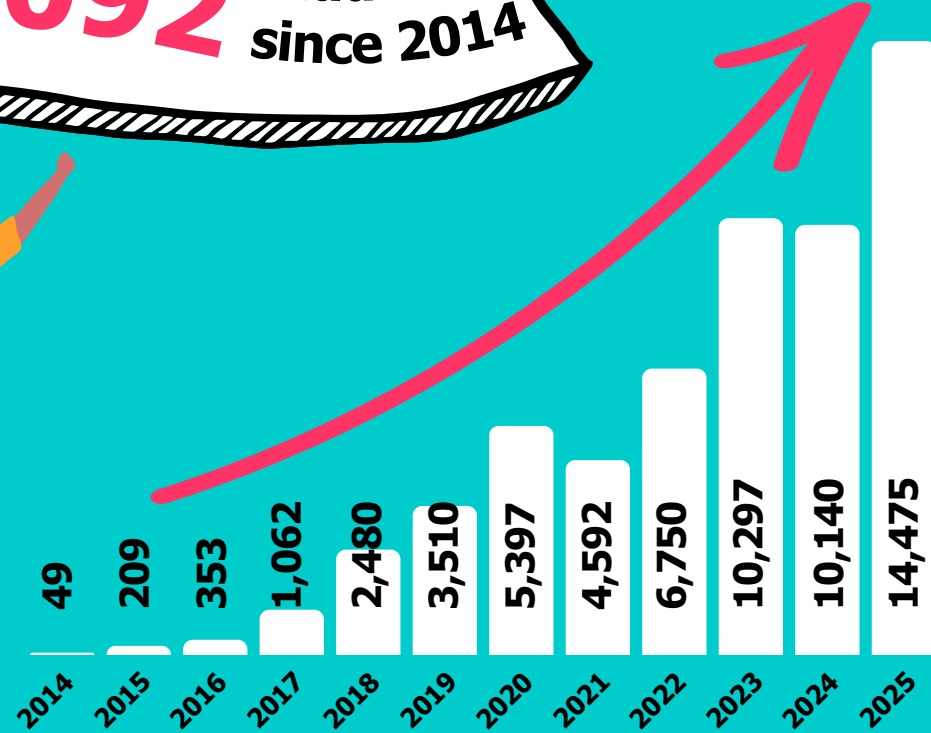

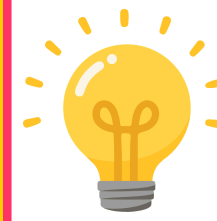

## Programs



### How We Impact the Next Generation of Coders



#### Clubhouse

We provide after-school and weekend classes that cover a wide range of STEM topics for all levels of skill and experience.

#### micro:bit for All

We work with districts in our communities to get a micro:bit kit in the hands of every 5th grader in the DMV (District of Columbia, Maryland, Virginia).

#### Summer Camp

We offer girls-only and coed camps for ages 8+ to learn computer science and engineering fundamentals through a series of unique projects and hands-on challenges.

#### Scholarships

We offer full scholarships for any students who cannot afford to pay for Clubhouse. We also offer scholarships for our after-school programs in Title 1 (low-income) schools.

In 2025 we moved our Montgomery County Summer Camps and Clubhouses from Bethesda to Silver Spring to better serve the low-income community.

#### Curriculum for Schools

We work with teachers and school districts to develop and share lesson plans for in-school STEM learning and after-school programs like Clubhouse.

#### Girl Scouts

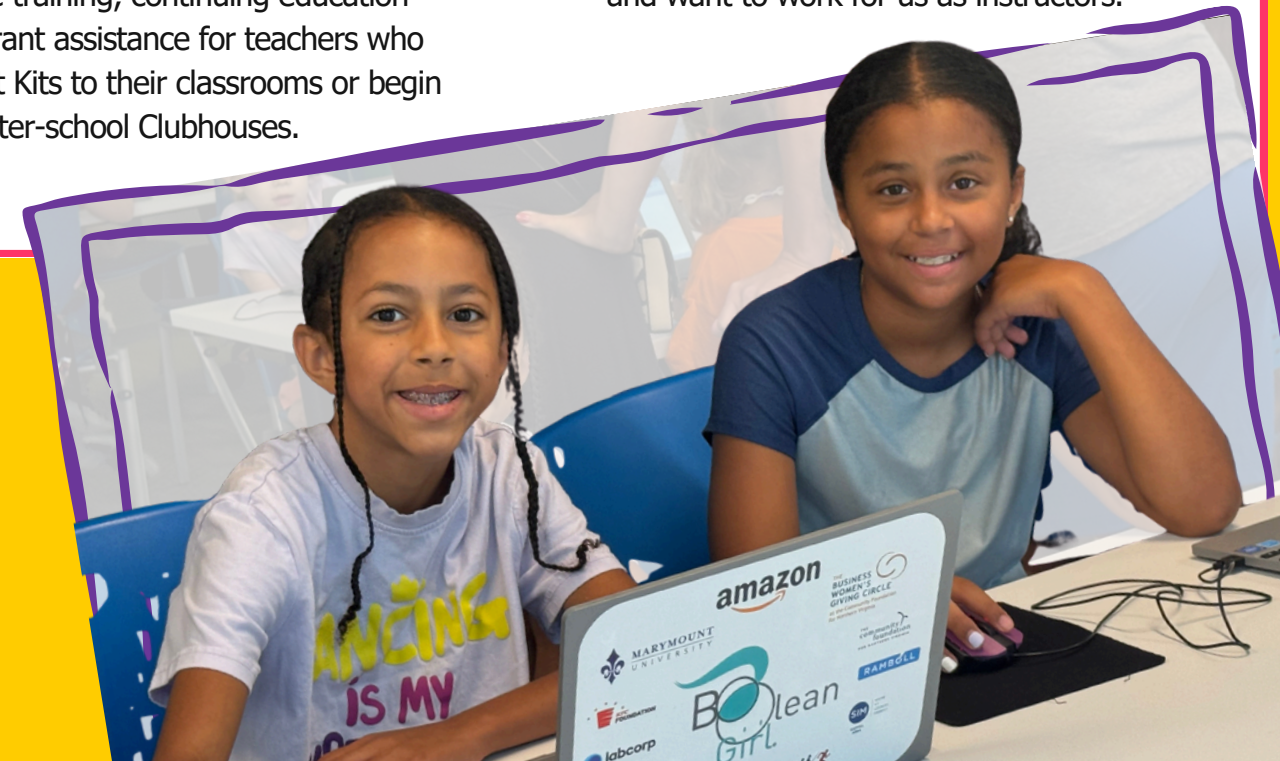
We offer certificates for completion of the Coding Basics badge following Clubhouse classes, which are always free for Girl Scouts. Troops and individuals are welcome!

#### Student-Teachers

We provide leadership opportunities to girls who graduate from our programs or other STEM programs and want to work for us as instructors.

#### Teacher Resources

We offer free online training, continuing education opportunities, and grant assistance for teachers who wish to bring micro:bit Kits to their classrooms or begin their own after-school Clubhouses.

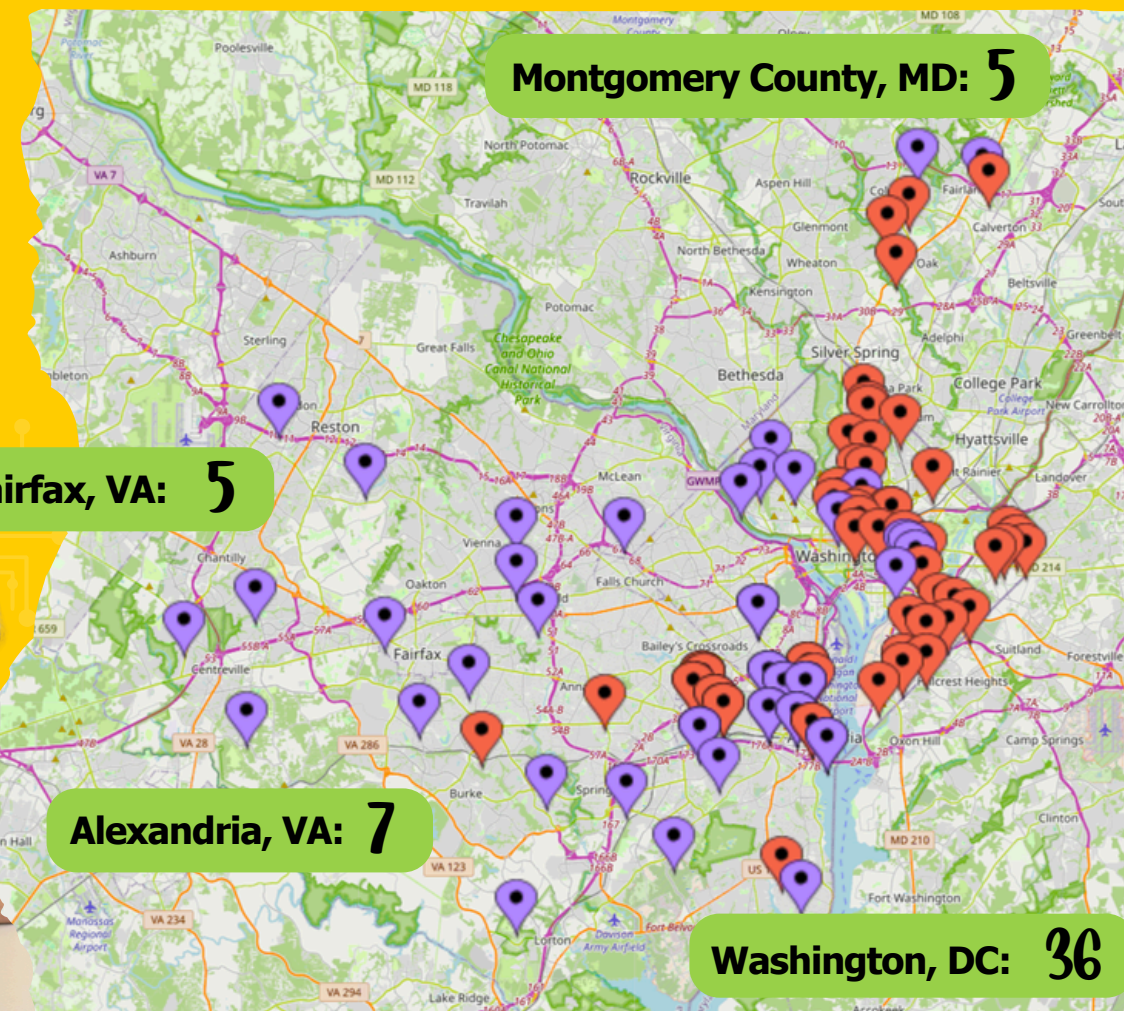
